I have been working with the Stone Soup Leadership Institute's team since 2011. I started as a youth delegate in the Institute's Sustainable Hawaii Youth Leadership Initiative (SHYLI) chapter. I have witnessed the growth of the Institute as a high school student, young adult and now a project coordinator.

I'm most impressed that the Institute's initiatives are driven by the interests of youth. The Institute and its partners are focused on creating a path for youth to become young adults who care about the environment and find ways to make an important impact on the world. As a high school student, I envisioned and then got strategic support from the Institute to pass a Resolution in the State of Hawaii to incorporate sustainable education and environmental leadership at the classroom level.
