- 100's of youth empowered to become leaders and challenge leaders for actionable policies for climate change.
- Engaged 100's of mentors for Martha's Vineyard youth.

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The Institute worked with education, community and business leaders to develop year-round youth leadership programs that empowered youth to become leaders & create partnerships to envision a Sustainable Martha's Vineyard.

The Challenges

- The Martha's Vineyard Commission conducted a 5-year community-wide planning process to determine the Island's needs and develop a vision for its future. However, this comprehensive Island Plan didn't include its future leaders: young people's voices.

Strategic Implementation

- MVYLI youth were trained to work with the MV Commission's top cartographer to create a **Sustainable Vineyard Map** as a visible way to share their vision for a sustainable Martha's Vineyard, empowering them to push for meaningful change.
- Youth represented U.S. Secretary Kerry's Ocean Summit with Dr. Sylvia Earle, Leonardo DiCaprio, Monaco's Prince Albert.
- **Youth Leadership Summits** with global island youth
- Vieques youth leaders trained MVYLI youth to develop Sustainable 2020 Vision Report.
